

As a beekeeper, I've learned a lot about balance, patience, and working with nature — not against it. Bees waste nothing. Every resource in the hive has a purpose, and every action serves the good of the whole. That mindset has shaped the way I approach sustainability in our industry.

In the world of temporary event and media structures, waste — especially wood waste — is a constant issue. Scaffold boards, plywood, offcuts... too often, they're used once and discarded. For me, that's never sat right.

At Event and Media Structures, we've always looked for ways to reuse and repurpose materials. From giving scaffold boards a second life to turning scrap timber into kindling, sustainability isn't just a policy — it's personal.

Looking ahead, one of our goals is to transform clean wood waste from the events industry into chipboard panels for sustainable housing — a practical step towards a circular economy.

We're already experimenting with smaller-scale ideas too. Even the smallest offcuts, like sawdust, are being put to use: we're now growing oyster mushrooms in our warehouse using it as a growing medium.

We're also working with local authorities and recycling experts to expand these initiatives, aiming to make wood recovery and reuse standard practice across our sector.

Temporary structures shouldn't come with temporary thinking. By learning from nature — and from bees — we can find smarter, more sustainable ways to build. Let's create something that lasts, not just for events, but for the environment and future generations.


